The Land Trust Accreditation Commission which helps ensure land trusts create and implement sound land conservation policies and procedures, announced today that the Wyoming Stock Growers Agricultural Land Trust (“WSGALT”) is applying for renewal of its 2012 accreditation.

A public comment period is now open.

The commission is an independent program of the Land Trust Alliance, which conducts an extensive review of each applicant’s policies and programs.

“Accreditation helps ensure land trusts create and implement solid policies and procedures,” said Bo Alley, executive director of the WSGALT.

The Land Trust Accreditation Commission, which recognizes and accredits land conservation organizations that meet national quality standards for protecting important natural places and working lands forever.

The commission invites public input and accepts signed, written comments on pending applications. Comments must relate to how WSGALT complies with national quality standards. These standards address the ethical and technical operation of a land trust. For the full list of standard go here.
