

# THE KURT BUCHOLZ AWARD

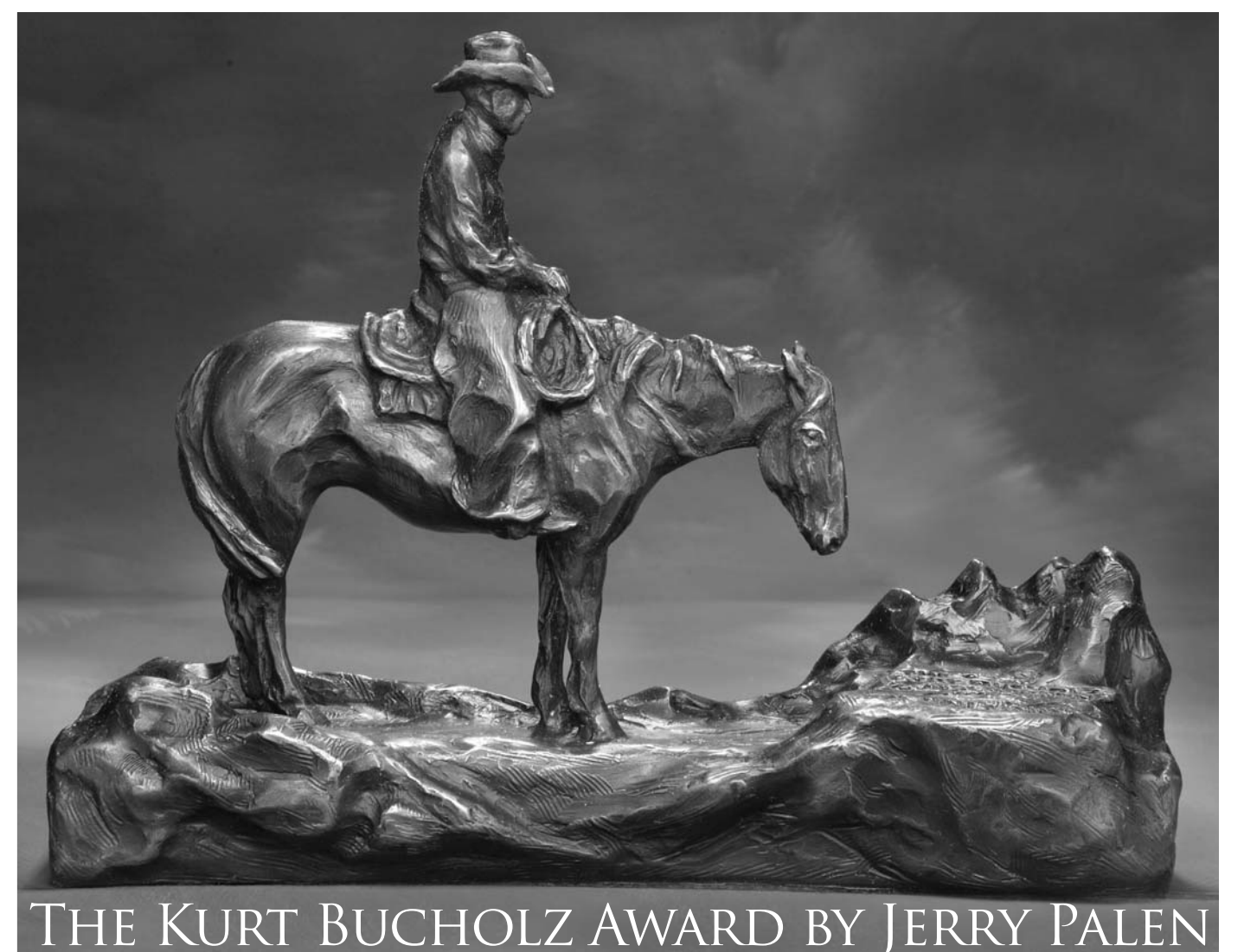
*recognizing excellence in conservation*



The Kurt Bucholz Award was established in memory of Dr. Bucholz, DVM, a legislator and rancher from Saratoga, Wyo. The award honors an individual who exemplifies the core beliefs held by Dr. Bucholz during his productive lifetime of dedicated public service and commitment to conservation of working ranchlands.

Award recipients have achieved a lasting impact in one or more of the following ways:

- Ardent supporter of conserving Wyoming's working landscapes and an individual who recognizes the indispensable role of ranching in this endeavor.
- Astute and successful rancher and land steward who has been active in state and/or national natural resource issues, and a strong proponent of private enterprise and private solutions for conservation in Wyoming.
- A background of actions promoting the bedrock importance of water to Wyoming and the vital significance of protecting traditional water rights.
- A strong and abiding interest in hunting and wildlife and a personal commitment to habitat conservation.
