The Wyoming Stock Growers Land Trust was the lucky draw for a bison tag through the Governor's Big Game License Coalition, administered by Wyoming Wildlife – The Foundation. The wild bison license will be sold by auction and will benefit both the Wyoming Stock Growers Land Trust and The Foundation. Bids can be made on-line at [Bidding for Good](#) or at a live auction to be held at the Land Trust's Annual Round-up barbeque which will be held on August 29th.

Other items to be auctioned include the opportunity to have your name in a novel penned by award-winning Wyoming author CJ Box, an antique horse-drawn buggy, a cow elk hunt, a guided fishing trip, western jewelry and a variety of getaways!

The Annual Roundup is the Wyoming Stock Growers Land Trust's signature event each summer. The organization will be awarding the 2015 Kurt Bucholz Conservation Award, serving up a beef dinner, touring the conservation easement at the historic Warren Livestock Co.'s Pole Creek Ranch, and providing an opportunity to mingle with friends from throughout the state. Live and silent auctions help to raise operating funds for the organization which celebrates its 15th Anniversary this year.
